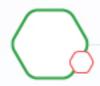

EXCURSIONS:

#1 WATERFALL DAY

Leaving the house at 9am, returning for 4 to 5pm. Minimum of 4 people. Cost per person: \$125.00 per person.



VISITING 3 WATERFALLS:

Emerald Pool, Jaco Falls and Spanney Falls. All fresh water, and swimmable. Cystral clear and refreshing water, surrounded by pristine jungle. Timed right, you will be the only tourists there, and that is what we are aiming for.

Beautiful clear and cool mountain waters cascading from high above, make for the perfect natural landscape. Wade into any of these 3 falls and be rejuvenated, and refreshed.

Upon returning to the house, we will stop off at Pagua Bay Restaurant and Grill for late lunch, early dinner.

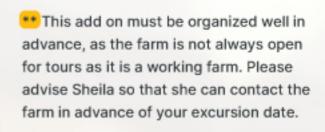
#2 RIVER TUBING

Leaving the house at 10am, returning at approx. 4pm. Minimum 4 people. Cost per person: \$ 115.00.

You will take a leisurely float with a guide down the Pagua River on inner tubes provided by us. There are deeper areas where you can swim in the clear, warm water, and lounge on the river shores next to beautiful jungle foliage. It's truly a beautiful, leisurely tour ... very relaxing, full of many memorable picture opportunities. It takes about 1.5 to 2 hours if you are taking your time. Which we suggest you do! Enjoy swimming in places along the river like Mermaid Pool. You will picked up at the end of the tubing and given the choice of going to a local restaurant, or returning to the house.

An option to add onto this excursion is to visit Soma Garden. This is an exotic fruit farm where you will be taken on a guided tour to learn all about the fascinating production of exotic fruits. You will also be able to sample some seasonal delights as well.

EXCURSIONS:

#3 BATIBOU BEACH AND SNORKEL DAY

Leaving the house at 10-11am, you will be driven to Batibou Beach. Minimum 4 people. Cost per person: \$100.00



Incredibly scenic with little to no other tourists! Quintessential Caribbean beach .. not to be missed. Little to no other tourists, palm trees stretched over white sand beach for as far as the eye can see. Warm crystal clear waters when you get there, you won't want to leave.

Also, a great snorkel spot with an easily accessible shallow reef.

You decide how long you would like to stay on the beach. After you have your fill of the beach, you will be taken to the village (Calibishie) for late lunch early dinner and then returned back to the house.

EXCURSIONS:

#4 HOT SPRINGS DAY AND COLD WATER LAKE

Leaving the house at 8:30am and returning 4-5 pm. This is a longer drive on typical island roads very scenic, but twisty, which takes approx. 1.5 hours. Minimum of 4 people. Cost per person: \$175.00.

You will be driven to Ti Kwen Glo Cho Sulphur Hotsprings. The 3 hotspring pools are set in gorgeous, lush tropical gardens, the waters range from 35 to 45c, and are very therapeutic. They flow directly from Dominica's volcanic, thermal underground. There are plenty of cold fresh water showers to cool off under as well.





Upon leaving the hotsprings, we will take a scenic drive up to FreshWater Lake. This is a serene and very quiet area set high up in the mountains, nestled in the Morne Trois Petons national park, at an elevation of 2,500 hundred feet.

EXCURSIONS:

#5 INDIAN RIVER PADDLE AND PORTS MOUTH BEACH

Leaving the house at 9am, returning at 4-5pm, traveling to Portsmouth approx.45 mins away. Minimum 4 people. Cost per person: \$ 125.00.



Take a guided tour up the Indian River taking in a Pirates of the Caribbean movie set, (sounds hoaky, but its actually really interesting!) as well as learning all about the local flora and fauna. There are no gas powered motors allowed along the river. Your guide will paddle you along the clear river waters, all the while sharing with you local history as well as informing you how the river impacts current inhabitants. You may be able to get a local "jelly" which is a very young coconut freshly harvested ... drink the nourishing coconut water and scoop out the coconut jelly.

Very much like a custard, and extremely nutritious. The paddle ends at a tropical bar and
garden, where you can relax and enjoy a rum
punch or beer, or not! and tour the gardens.
Upon returning to the dock, you will be picked
up and driven to the Ports Mouth Beach. There
you can swim in the Caribbean, and enjoy good
local food. Your return will be via the scenic
North Country, where you can stop at some
truly breath taking vistas of Dominica's mountains and Atlantic shoreline.

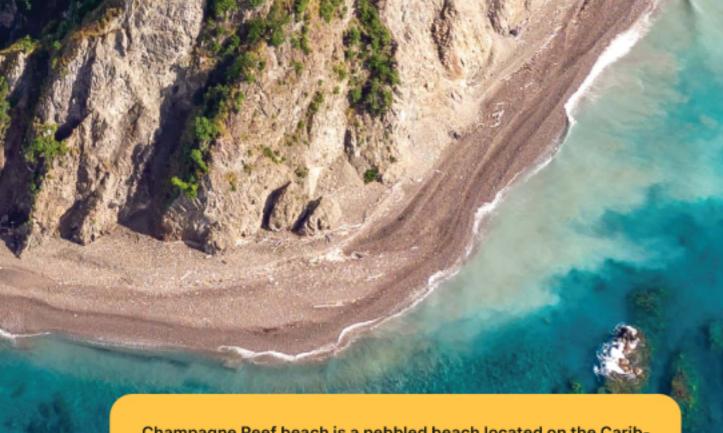

#6 CHAMPAGNE REEF BEACH DAY

Leaving the house at 8:30 am, returning 4-5 pm. Travel is almost 2 hours each way on this excursion, but worth it as you will be headed towards one of the most southern points of the island. 4 person minimum. Cost per person: \$160.00



Champagne Reef beach is a pebbled beach located on the Caribbean side of the island. Volcanic air bubbles up through the ocean floor making it look and feel like you are swimming in light champagne bubbles. Here you can snorkel, soak up the sun, relax under palm frond shades, and enjoy the ocean waves.

Upon returning we will stop at a restaurant.

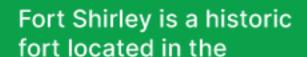

EXCURSIONS:

#7 FORT SHIRLEY DAY

Leaving the house at 8:30 am, travelling to the historic Fort Shirley in Ports Mouth. Returning at 3-4pm. Minimum 4 people.

Cost per person: \$120.00.



Cabrits ——— National Park.





Both British and French soldiers have occupied the Fort in the 18th century. The grounds offer many well kept original and rebuilt structures as well as spectacular views of Ports Mouth Harbour.

After touring the fort, you will then be taken to a local restaurant for lunch and return on the scenic North Route, including a stop at Cold Soufriere Springs which is a naturally occurring Sulphur Springs you can view from a platform after a small hike.

EXCURSIONS:

#8 TOWN DAY

Leaving the house at 9 am, we will drop you off in town (here on the island, when you are going to town, you are going to Roseau) at approx. 10:30. This is a self guided tour in Dominica's capital city. Minimum 4 people. Cost per person: \$100.00.



Here you can explore at your leisure, the colonial town of Roseau. A bustling small city where cobblestone streets, and traditional wooden houses coexist next to modern shopping and amenities.

Cruise ships pull into port here, so there is plenty of souvenir stalls, shopping, duty free, grocery stores and places of interest such as museums, botanical gardens and restaurants.

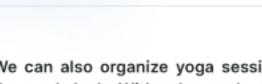
We depart from Roseau from a designated pick up and drop off at 3:30 pm. Back to Hodges Bay House by 5pm.

REMINDER:

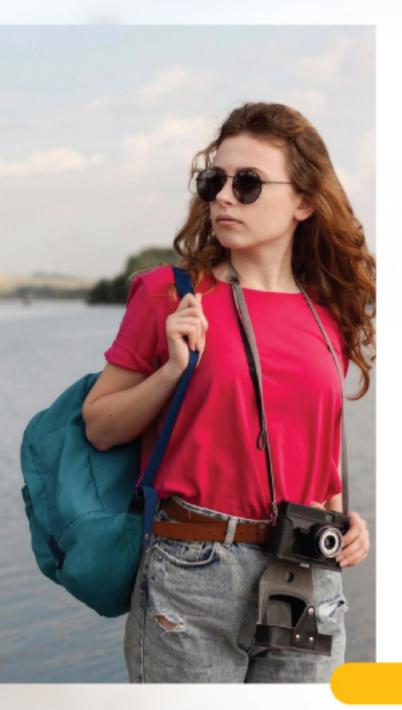
Here on Dominica there are: no poisonous animals or insects, or dangerous fresh water critters. Kinda makes life a lot less stressful

A Suggested Packing List:

- Quick dry clothing
- Sandals that can be worn in water, or on a hike (strappy, hiking kind) or water shoes
- Sun hat

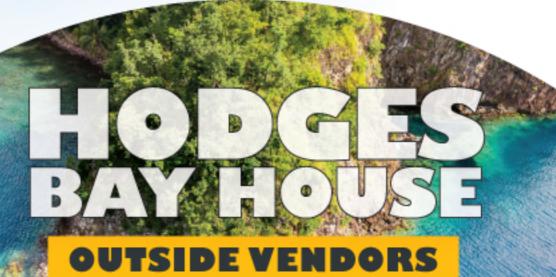
-In each suite's bathroom you will find: body wash, shampoo and conditioner, and a hair dryer, so no need to pack those items/ toiletries. We also include beach towels.

Boiling Lake hike includes: guide, pick up and drop off. This is a once in a life time adventure, 2nd biggest boiling lake in the world, but you must be fit. This hike is rated extremely difficult. Cost per person:

\$100. 2 person minimum.

Spear Fishing. Night and day, subject to moon cycle and guide availability. Catch your own lunch or dinner! Cost per person:
